

JOHN GATLING GRANT PROGRAM

John Gatling was a Raleigh, North Carolina businessman, contractor, and real estate executive. He was a loyal and supportive North Carolina State University alumnus, and it was his desire that his estate be used primarily for educational scholarships. Gatling established the grant at NC State for first time undergraduate, degree-seeking students who are born with the surname Gatlin or Gatling. No other spelling of the surname is eligible.

The value of the grant may vary from year to year and is dependent on the number of recipients and the amount of available funding.

To be considered for a Gatling Grant, candidates must do the following:

- Submit a Notification of Interest to the Office of Scholarships & Financial Aid.
- Submit an NC State Undergraduate Admission application and materials by February 1.
- Complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at www.fafsa.ed.gov no later than March 1.
- Be accepted for admission to NC State University no later than April 1.
- Submit a copy of a birth certificate, confirming the name Gatlin or Gatling, to the Office of Scholarships & Financial Aid.

Due to increasing demand, it has become necessary for the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid to establish the following priorities in awarding Gatling Grants:

- North Carolina residents attending NC State with the surname Gatlin(g) who demonstrate financial need as determined by the FAFSA
- Non-North Carolina residents attending NC State with the surname Gatlin(g) who demonstrate financial need as determined by the FAFSA
- North Carolina residents attending NC State with the surname Gatlin(g) who do not demonstrate financial need.
- Non-North Carolina residents attending NC State with the surname Gatlin(g) who do not demonstrate financial need.
- As of the 2002-03 academic year, funds have been available for students attending NC State University only. In the event that additional funding is available, additional priorities will be considered.
