Some employees must work on holidays/closings to meet operational needs. To confirm that additional compensation is applicable, review information on the additional compensation schedule.

Employees may ask to take leave for major religious observances. Supervisors must arrange work schedules so the employees can take leave if the day is a major religious observance and does not create an emergency situation in the department.

The University's holidays/closings differ from the schedule established by the Office of State Personnel. Campuses of the University of North Carolina system observe the holidays/closings provided to other State agencies. However, each campus sets its own specific holiday/closing schedule based on institutional needs.
