<u>Mandatory Fee</u>	<u>Requested Amount</u>	<u>Description of Fee</u>
<i>Union Activity Board Fee</i>	\$ 14.63	The Union Activities Board is the main programming body for the campus which is responsible for acquiring, scheduling, publicizing, and presenting films, speakers, and special events.
<i>Student Publications Fee</i>	\$ 15.00	This fee is used to defray the cost of the various campus-wide student publications. At present these include two student newspapers, a yearbook, a radio station, and "The Windover" (a literary magazine).
<i>Student Government Fee</i>	\$ 10.85	This fee is allocated to the Student Government for distribution to Campus organizations for activities, they deem, are in the best interest of the student body.
<i>Student Legal Services Fee</i>	\$ 10.00	This fee funds the student legal services program which offers legal services to all students.
<i>Reserve - Student Affairs</i>	\$ 0.20	This fee serves as a contingency against unanticipated expenses involving student programs.
<i>School (Student Association) Fee*</i>		
<i>Undergraduates</i>	\$ 5.00	This fee is used by the student body to support student activities of each of the various schools.
<i>Graduates</i>	\$ 16.00	This fee is used by the graduate student association to support graduate student activities.
<i>Student Center Operations Fee</i>	\$ 218.40	This fee supports the operations, activities, and programs offered by the University Student Center.
<i>Student Center Repairs and Renovations Fee</i>	\$ 28.70	This fee is used to maintain and upgrade the Talley Student Center, Price Music Center, Witherspoon Student Center and Thompson Theater.
<i>Recreational Sports Fee</i>	\$ 121.10	This fee is used to defray the cost of operating and maintaining the intramural recreational sports program and other physical education programs.
<i>Association of Student Governments Fee</i>	\$ 1.00	This UNC Board of Governors approved fee for all UNC institutions to help finance the Association of Student Governments, a coalition of student leaders from across the state. To be used for administrative staff, travel and small stipends for student leaders.
<i>Intercollegiate Athletics Fee</i>	\$ 150.50	This fee is used in partial support of intercollegiate athletic programs.
<i>Student Health Service Fee - Operations</i>	\$ 245.62	This fee is used by the University Health Center to offer medical and counseling services to students.
<i>Educational & Technology Fee</i>	\$ 386.00	This academic fee is used by colleges and schools to equip and operate computing and scientific laboratories which supplement classroom instruction.
<i>Transit Operations Fee (Bus Service)</i>	\$ 130.00	This fee partially funds the campus transit system.
<i>Indebtedness Fees</i>		
<i>Thompson Theatre Building - Indebtedness</i>	\$ 38.00	This fee is pledged to support renovation for the Thompson Theatre Building.
<i>Student Health Service - Indebtedness</i>	\$ -	This fee is pledged to retire bonds issued for the construction of a new student health services facility.
<i>Student Health Service - Expansion</i>	\$ 35.00	This fee is pledged to support an addition for the Student Health Services Building.
<i>Intercollegiate Athletics - Indebtedness</i>	\$ 96.00	This fee is pledged to the Department of Athletics in support of facility improvements, renovations, repairs and maintenance.
<i>Carmichael Recreational Center - Indebtedness</i>	\$ 45.00	This fee is pledged to retire bonds issued for construction of the Carmichael Gymnasium Expansion.
<i>Carmichael Complex - Indebtedness</i>	\$ 23.00	This fee is pledged to support repairs and renovations of outdated equipment and facilities at Carmichael Complex
